Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <i>MEMBER FIRST MORTGAGE, LLC has no affiliates.</i>	
Non-Affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <i>MEMBER FIRST MORTGAGE, LLC does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.</i>	
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. MEMBER FIRST MORTGAGE, LLC doesn't jointly market.
